It is hard to be sure what school will be like in September, but we expect to be returning to some normality. I will email parents at the end of the holiday to confirm any changes and the teachers will also send further information to the children on Google Classroom.

Beginning and end of the day

We will not be continuing the staggered start, so we ask everyone to arrive between 8.45- 9.00am. A member of staff will meet the children at each entrance. At the end of the day the children can be collected from the playground at 3pm.

School Uniform

It is worth reminding everyone of the school's uniform expectations, so that we can start the new school year in the right manner. The school uniform is grey or navy trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress; white or pale blue shirt or blouse; navy blue jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt; black shoes. A blue and white checked dress can be worn in warmer months. Children may wear a wristwatch and a single stud in each pierced ear. No other jewellery or temporary tattoos are to be worn.

PE

We will continue to ask the children to come to school in their PE kit on days when they have PE. The school's PE kit is plain white t-shirt, navy or black shorts and trainers. In colder months a navy or black tracksuit can be worn. No jewellery may be worn for PE, so children will need a small container for any ear studs. It would be helpful for all piercings to be arranged for the first week of the summer holidays to avoid missing PE lessons. Juniors will need two pairs of trainers: one for use outdoors and one to be kept clean for use in the hall.
