This term's topics:


For the first half term our topic will be a science topic on forces. We will be carrying out investigations and learning about gravity, friction, air resistance, water resistance and how levers and gears work. We will be designing and making our own moving vehicles in DT.

After half term, we will move onto a history topic on the Maya. We will be finding out about their beliefs and way of life, making comparisons to life in Britain at the time. We will design Maya inspired masks in art.



## English

In English, we will be using the book 'The man who walked between the towers' as inspiration for some narrative writing before starting a poetry unit based on the work of Benjamin Zephaniah. We will then read a Maya myth called 'The rain player' and will write our own mystery stories..



## Maths

We will be doing lots of revision in the weeks before the SATs tests.. After the tests are complete, we will be working on a project about budgets and spending to go with our PSHE work on money and will be carrying out some mathematical investigations.
