



# Holt Community Primary School Newsletter Autumn No. 3 25th September 2012



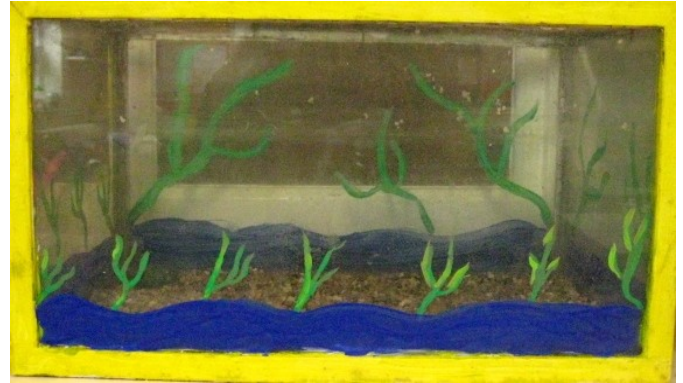
