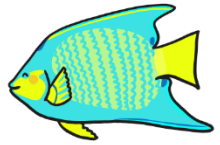


## Welcome to the Summer Term!



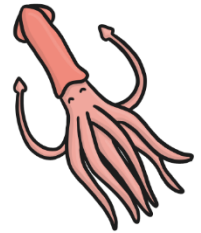

**P.E:** The children will be learning how to play cricket this term. Outdoor shoes will be required. P.E. continues to be on Tuesdays and Fridays.

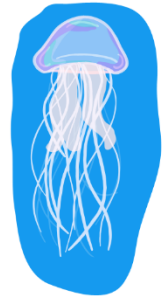
