English: We have begun learning about Ancient Roman legends and will be using them as inspiration for our own. We will also be looking at newspapers to help us write our own articles.

Maths: As our topic is Ancient Rome, we will be learning about the Roman number system and will be on the hunt for Roman Numerals. We will later be working on multiplication and division.
